ST JOHN'S HILL/PLOUGH ROAD/STRATH TERRACE JUNCTION & ST JOHN'S HILL BRIDGE MAINTENANCE WORKS – ROAD WORKS NOTIFICATION 22-25 AUGUST

Please find attached a copy of work notification letter from the Council, regarding the St John's Hill/Plough Road, Strath Terrace Junction Resurfacing and St John's Hill Bridge Remedial Works. Details also below:

ST JOHN'S HILL/PLOUGH ROAD/STRATH TERRACE JUNCTION RESURFACING AND ST JOHN'S HILL BRIDGE REMEDIAL WORKS

As a part of our borough wide programme to improve roads and bridges, we will shortly be carrying out the following two sets of carriageways resurfacing works:

St John's Hill/Plough Road/Strath Terrace Junction resurfacing (Night-time works)

This works will include the removal and replacement of the existing road surface of St John's Hill/Plough Road/Strath Terrace junction including a section of Strath Terrace between the junction and Strath Terrace Bridge. These works are essential to improve the safety and condition of the road.

This work is programmed to commence on Monday 22nd August 2022 and anticipated to be completed by Thursday 25th August 2022, weather and other conditions permitting. To keep the disruption in the area to a minimum, the work will be carried out between the hours of 20:00hrs to 05.00hrs each night. Vehicular traffic on St John's Hill will be allowed to run under two-way traffic control, but the side roads Plough Road and Strath Terrace will be closed during the works.

St John's Hill Bridge Remedial resurfacing works (Daytime works)

This works will include the removal and replacement of the defective road surface of St John's Hill Bridge. These works are essential to improve the safety and condition of the road and bridge.

The works are programmed to commence on Tuesday 30th August 2022 and anticipated to be completed by Wednesday 31st August 2022, weather and other conditions permitting. The work will be carried out between the hours of 08:00hrs to 17:00hrs, without road closure.

please be assured that we will make every effort to complete the work as planned and keep inconvenience to an absolute minimum. The Council's contractor, FM Conway Ltd will strive as much as possible to maintain safe access to your property. We ask that you discuss any specific access needs with the site staff who will be able to direct you safely through the works.

However, at times, it is possible that works can be delayed, for example, due to unforeseen conditions. If that happens, I ask for your cooperation and forbearance while we deliver these improvements.

Please do not park in 'No Waiting' coned area as this can delay the work progress. If a vehicle is parked in the coned off area, the Council may have no alternative than to relocate the vehicle to an adjacent road. Should this need occur, full details of the relocation will be available directly from the supervising Engineer on site or via 0208 871 8147.
